On the death of Thomas S. Kimball

1 Whereas, Thomas S. Kimball died at his home in
2 Thatcher, on October 30, 1939; and

3 Whereas, this Arizona pioneer can never be forgotten
4 for his contributions to his community and his state in the
5 fields of business, religion, social welfare, and govern-
6 ment; and

7 Whereas, the deceased, in addition to his valued ser-
8 vices in the development of the state, brought prominence
9 to his name and credit to Graham county as a member of
10 the senate of the sixth, eighth, and ninth legislatures;

12 *Be it resolved by the Senate of the State of Arizona:*
